		Senior Camper has chosen to participate in this program, and by doing so has been given a reduced camp fee. This reduced fee does require camper to participate in a minimum of 80 program hours during the regular camp day (9:00 a.m. $-$ 3:00 p.m.)
		Senior Camper is expected to be courteous, friendly and respectful to all other campers, recognizing that this is a key component to being a strong leader.
		Senior Camper is expected to be courteous, friendly and respectful of all other senior campers, recognizing that this is a key element to being a member of a team.
		Senior Camper is expected to deal with problems with other campers in a safe, calm manner and will always choose to resolve issues in a mature and respectful way.
		Senior Camper understands that social cruelty (bullying, teasing, sarcasm and criticism or words that are intended to be a "put down") will not be tolerated.
		Senior Camper understands that there is a zero tolerance policy for any type of physical violence (hitting, fighting, restraining, etc.).
		Senior Camper agrees to be involved in the planning and implementation of at least one special event or activity for the younger campers at Camp Edna.
		Senior Camper agrees to be involved in at least one community service project during the 7 weeks of camp. Camper will have the opportunity to provide input regarding what type(s) of community service project(s) will be accomplished.
		Senior Camper understands that any disciplinary action taken regarding violation of any camp rules may result in loss of senior camper status; Camp discount will no longer apply and parent will be required to pay a prorated fee in order to keep child in camp for remainder of summer.
		Senior Camper understands that <u>successful</u> completion of the Senior Camper Program will guarantee a Junior Counselor position for the following summer. If the senior camper does not follow through on all expectations of the senior camper position, that camper will need to go through the competitive selection process for Junior Counselors for the following summer. Successful Senior Campers will be given Certificate of Completion at end of summer.
